ORDER

As per the G.O. read above, Government have constituted the Kerala State Information Commission in accordance with the Right to Information Act 2005 enacted by the Parliament. It has been laid down under section 15 of the Act that the Commission shall consist of a State Chief Information Commissioner and such number of State Information Commissioners as may be deemed necessary, whose appointment shall be made by the Governor, on the recommendation of a Committee consisting of (i) the Hon. Chief Minister, who shall be the Chairperson of the Committee (ii) the Leader of Opposition in the Legislative Assembly and (iii) a Minister to be nominated by the Chief Minister. Accordingly, Government are pleased to constitute a Committee consisting of (i) Hon. Chief Minister (Chairperson), (ii) Hon. Leader of Opposition and (iii) Hon. Minister for Finance & Excise (Members) for making recommendations to the Governor for the appointment of State Chief Information Commissioner and State Information Commissioners of the Kerala State Information Commission.
